Before the adoption of the modern Gregorian calendar in 1752, the New Year was celebrated on what is now 14 January and in some parts of the Highlands, this tradition survived until the early part of the 20th century. The Atholl Country Life Museum's popular celebration of the Auld New Year is a ceilidh which recalls the traditions of this festival with an evening of Scottish music, song and dance until after "the bells". The supper of homemade soup, oatcakes with cheese and clootie dumpling. Refreshments will be available from the bar.
